Christopher Thornberg is a founding principal of Beacon Economics and widely considered to be one of California's leading economic forecasters. An expert in economic forecasting, regional development, real estate dynamics, and labor markets, he was one of the earliest

and most adamant predictors of the housing market crash and of the economic recession that has followed. In 2008 he was appointed as chief economist for California State Controller John Chiang as well as chair of the Controller's Council of Economic Advisors. He also serves on Governor Arnold Schwarzenegger's Economic Strategy Panel, and on the advisory board of Paulson & Co. Inc., one of Wall Street's most successful hedge funds. Dr. Thornberg holds a Ph.D in Business Economics from The Anderson School at UCLA, and a B.S. in Business Administration from the State University of New York at Buffalo.

The great recession of 08-09 is over, but for the wrong reasons. Government policy rather than economic fundamental is driving the show, and in many cases this has stopped the healing process. What it implies is a turbulent recovery at best, a double dip at worst.
